Wage Subsidies*

Covering up to a maximum of 50% of your apprentice's gross income:

- For first year apprentices, you can receive up to a maximum of \$5,000**.
- For second to fifth year apprentices, you can receive up to a maximum of \$2,500.

Equipment & Training Subsidies***

This funding is available for your participating apprentices as follows:

A Equipment - All Apprentices:

\$250 per person

B Equipment - Female Apprentices:

\$750 per person

- ### C Training:
- Up to \$1,000 per contractor for an unlimited number of employees if at least 1 apprentice is an official participant. (e.g. health & safety, estimating, fire alarm technician, and more)..

* For payments, the apprentice's Registered Training Agreement and pay stub(s) showing their year-to-date gross income, excluding bonuses and expense reimbursements, are required.

** Providing the apprentice has worked for you for at least six weeks under their Training Agreement.

*** Proof of payment and other details are required for payment, as outlined on the Claim Form that will be provided.
