Since 1922, we've been providing vital industry, business, and technical trade knowledge to help our members grow their businesses and accelerate their employees' careers. The Employee Engagement Program is another example of our commitment to your success with benefits that include:

Wage Subsidies*

Covering up to a maximum of 50% of your apprentice's gross income:

- For first year apprentices, you can receive up to a maximum of \$5,000**.
- For second to fifth year apprentices, you can receive up to a maximum of \$2,500.

Support Youth Ontario (SOY) Sign-up/Registration Help

If an apprentice needs to be registered, or has an existing Training Agreement to transfer from a previous employer, you can turn to our partner Support Ontario Youth to take care of all the paperwork at no charge to you.

Equipment & Training Subsidies***

This funding is available for your participating apprentices as follows:

- A Equipment All apprentices: \$250 per person.
- **B** Equipment Female apprentices: \$750 per person.
- **C** Training: Up to \$1,000 per contractor for an unlimited number of employees if at least one apprentice is an official participant (e.g. health & safety, estimating, fire alarm technician and more).
